He went under for the second time! "MAMA! HELP ME!" He cried.


Without thinking, Selena jumped into the water.

"Why you hanging out with this loser when you can play with me?" Spike teased.


Leo looked over at Selena. She was trying to hide behind a tree.

Spike looked down at the ground. He was ashamed.


No one had ever treated him with kindness before - not ever!

That was the day that Spike changed his spots forever.


Now the three animals are the best of friends.
